

Canon CA-7 TEST SHEET

A test sheet is a piece of cardboard with precise markings that are designed to allow for particular things to be measured or checked.

By making a photocopy of a test sheet you can check for items such as focus, paper leading edge timing, distortion, centering, overall density and skew.
